

Sign up on Accounting Sheet in November, December, or January. Please indicate on your Accounting Sheet if you can drive for the carpool or if your student needs a ride.

Meet at the Aquarium at 9:30 a.m. We will be done at the Aquarium around 11:30 a.m. and head down to the beach for lunch. We will leave the beach at 2:00 p.m. to give ample time to arrive back at the church at 3:30 p.m. Bring a sack lunch and a beach towel.

CARPPOOLING INFO: Meet at the church at 8:15 a.m. and leave the parking lot at 8:30 a.m. sharp. Bring a Medical Release form filled out (see last page of Handbook or download from CCCA web site). Bring \$2.00 for gas money for the driver. **DO NOT PAY THIS ON YOUR ACCOUNTING SHEET.**

DIRECTIONS TO AQUARIUM: Take the I-15 South, Exit 56 fwy West; stay on the right. Merge onto I-5 South. Take exit 28-La Jolla Village Drive and turn right. Turn right on Torrey Pines Road. Take the first Left onto Expedition Way.

DIRECTIONS FROM BIRCH AQUARIUM TO LA JOLLA SHORES: Go East on Expedition Way. Left on Downwind Way. Left on La Jolla Shores Drive. Right on El Paseo Grande. El Paseo Grande turns into Camino Del Oro. Turn right into the second parking lot. We'll be at the grassy area to the left of the parking lot (if looking at the ocean.)

DIRECTIONS FROM LA JOLLA SHORES TO THE CHURCH: Exit parking lot, turn right onto Camino Del Oro. Turn right onto Vallecitus. Turn right on La Jolla Shores Drive. Make a left onto La Jolla Parkway. Merge onto the 52 East. Take the 15 North.

HELPFUL WEBSITE

ASSIST is an online student-transfer information system that shows how course credits earned at one public California college or university can be applied when transferred to another. This is helpful for those students who plan to start their college education at a community college and then transfer to a four year college or university. It is well worth your time to check out this website: www.assist.org.

ATTENTION ALL ATHLETES

If your student is considering playing sports in college, you should be regularly checking the NCAA clearinghouse website for any changes in requirements, eligibility and due dates for application. The website is: www.ncaaclearinghouse.net or www.ncaa.org. Click on "Student-athletes and Parents". You will apply with code #969999. There is also a toll free phone number (877) 262-1492. CCCA will complete any forms that the NCAA requires from the school, but it is the parent's responsibility to obtain and complete all other forms. Call Carmen at 834-9190, ext 1181 if you need further assistance.


CMCS CLASSES AND SPORTS

Those families with students taking classes and/or on a sport team should look at the school's (not the ISP's) website each day to determine if there are any changes to the schedule. The following link is where the daily advisement page is found: calvarychapelmurrieta.com. Click on "our school" and then click on "secondary" and go to the advisement page.

For those families trying out for or already on a sport team, you are required to attend the seasonal sports meetings. Please watch the newsletter and e-mails carefully for these meetings throughout the year for Winter, Spring and Summer sports.

SCHOLARSHIP TIPS FROM FASTWEB.COM

- NUMBER 1)** Complete the application in full. If a question doesn't apply, note that on the application. Don't just leave it blank.
- NUMBER 2)** Follow directions. Provide everything that is required, but don't supply things that aren't requested-you could be disqualified.
- NUMBER 3)** Neatness counts. Make several photocopies of all the forms you receive. Use the copies as working drafts to develop your application packet.
- NUMBER 4)** Make sure your essay makes an impression. The key to writing a strong essay is to be personal and specific. Include concrete details to make your experience come alive: who, what, when and where.
- NUMBER 5)** Watch for deadlines. Impose a deadline on yourself that is at least two weeks before the stated deadline.
- NUMBER 6)** Make copies before sending.
- NUMBER 7)** Remember-your scholarship application represents you!

ACADEMIC PROGRESS REPORTS

6th graders who played football and ran cross country and all 7th-12th grade students are required to turn in this report all year long.

Academic Progress Reports will be due at the **DECEMBER** and **MARCH** meetings. Be sure to mark your calendars and remember that you must turn in this report the first 3 quarters, even if your student does not play a sport. The late fee for this form is \$25 per student, per month.

IMPORTANT TESTING DATES

SAT - November 7, 2009, December 5, 2009, January 23, 2010, March 13, 2010, May 1, 2010 and June 5, 2010. Seniors must submit test scores by May, 2010, so the last test date that CCCA will accept for diploma purposes is **March 13, 2010**. Register @ www.collegeboard.com.

ACT - December 12, 2009, February 6, 2010, April 10, 2010, and June 12, 2010. Seniors must submit test scores by May, 2010 so the last test date that CCCA will accept for diploma purposes is **April 10, 2010**. Register @ www.actstudent.org.

CHSPE - March 20, 2010, and June 19, 2010. Seniors must submit test scores by May, so the last test date that CCCA will accept for diploma purposes is **March 20, 2010**. Register @ www.chspe.net

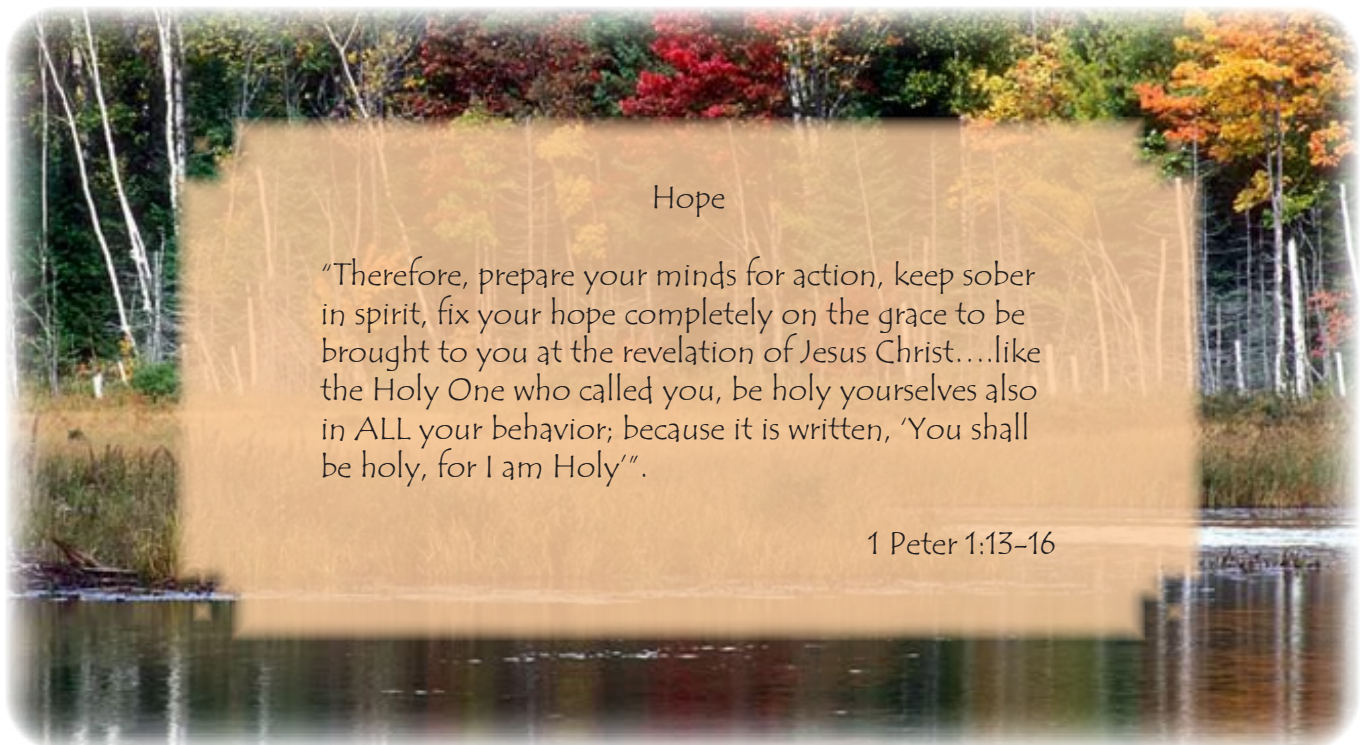
CAL GRANT INFORMATION
